

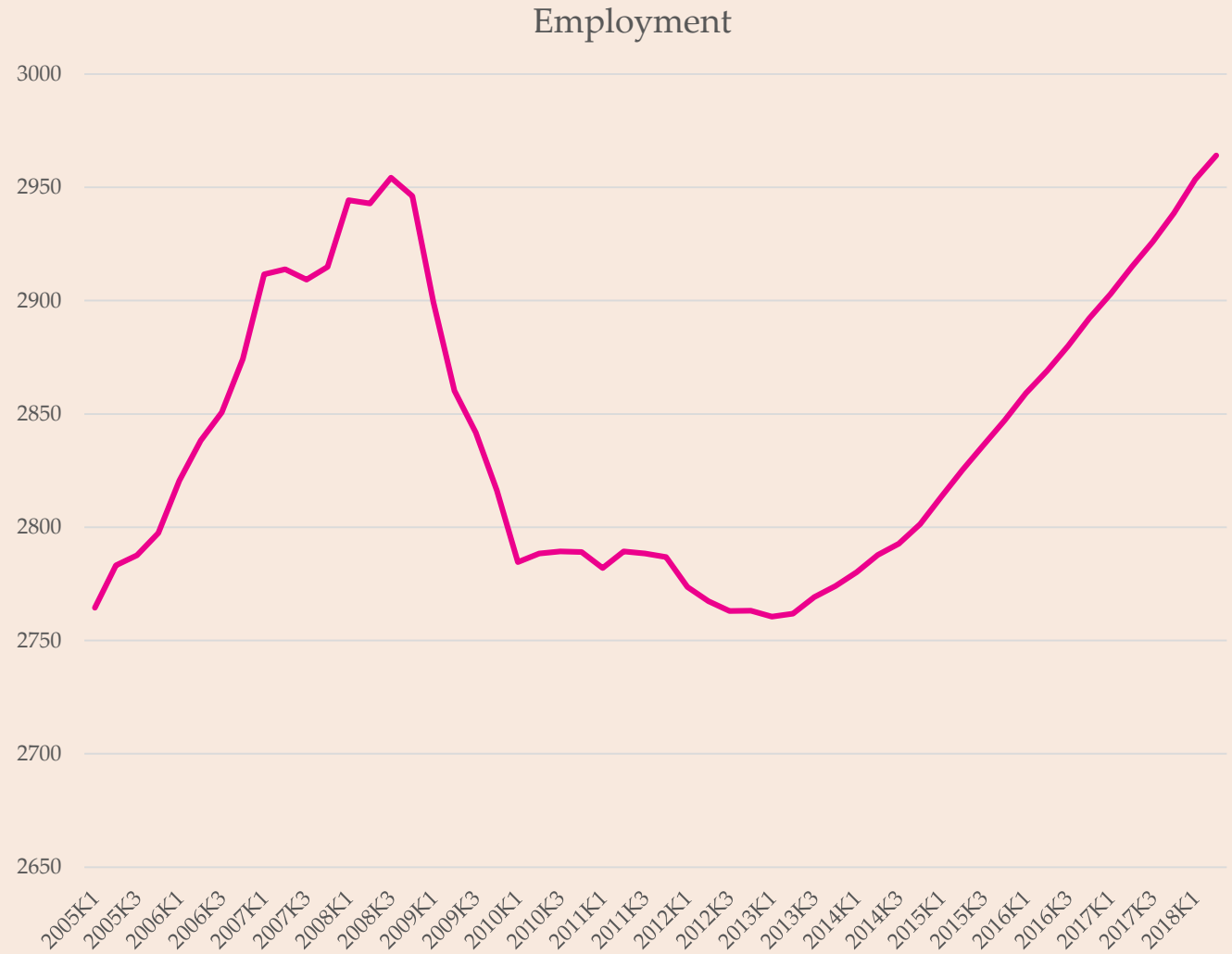

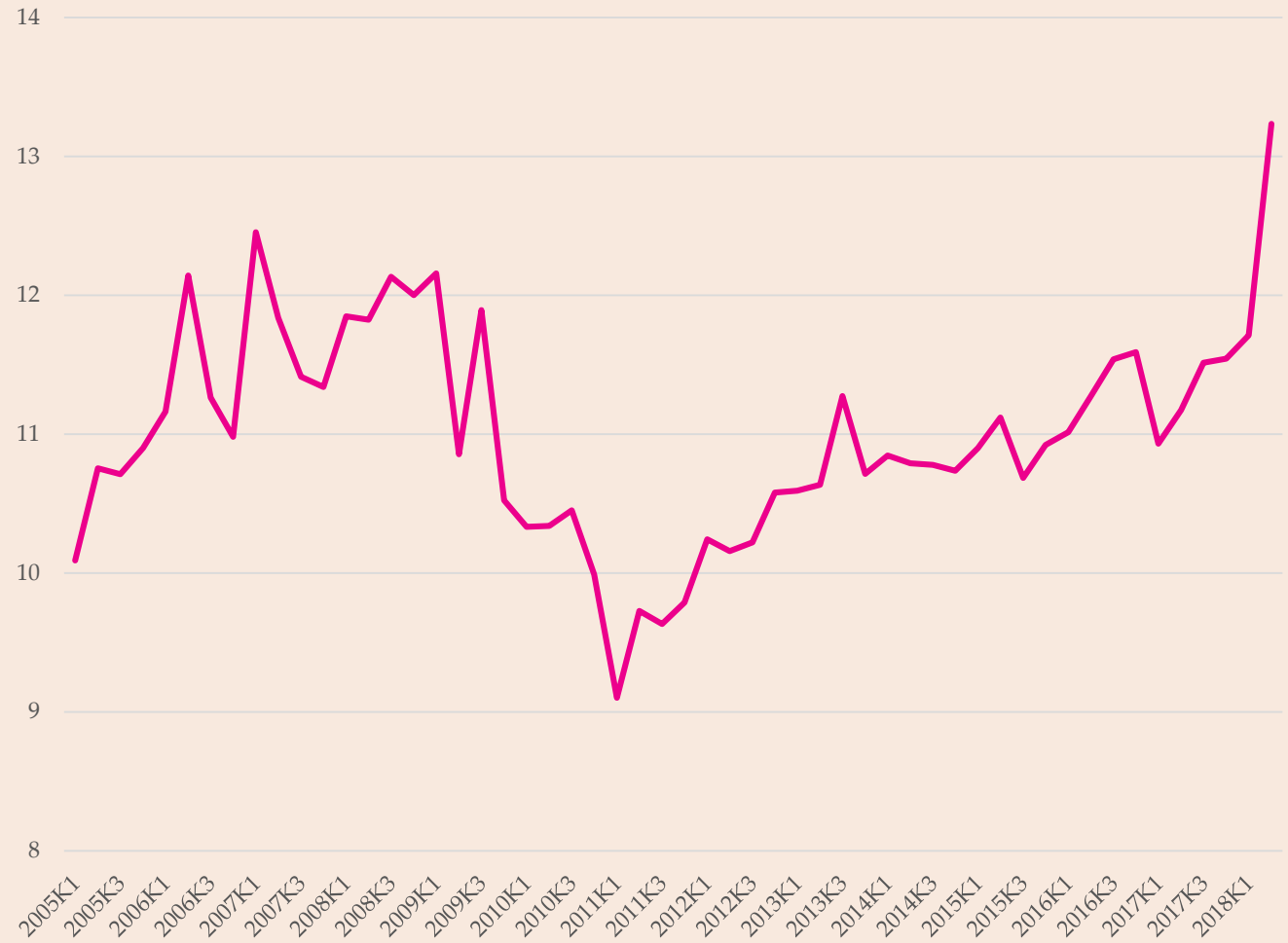

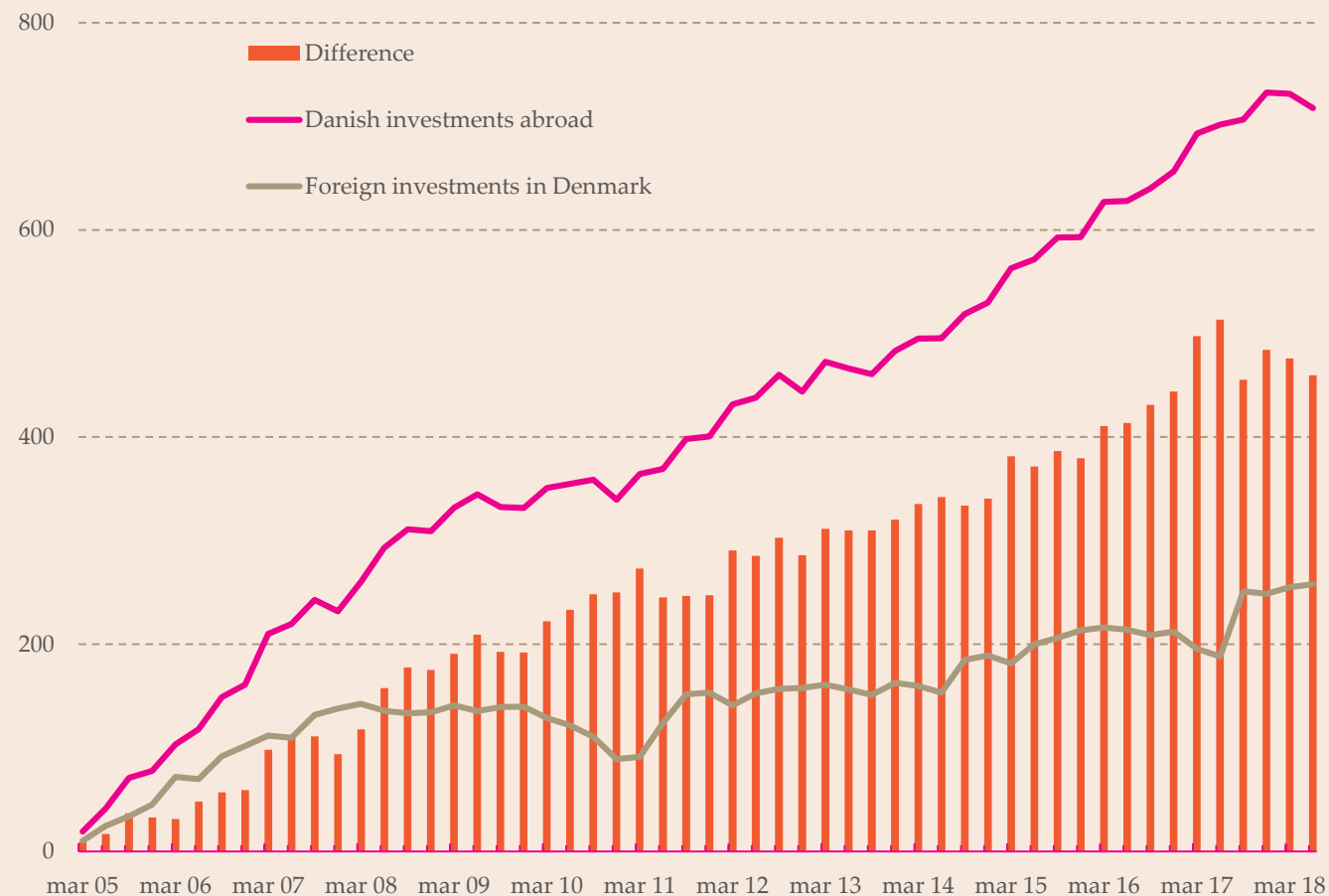
Investments

Business investments ex housing and construction share of GDP

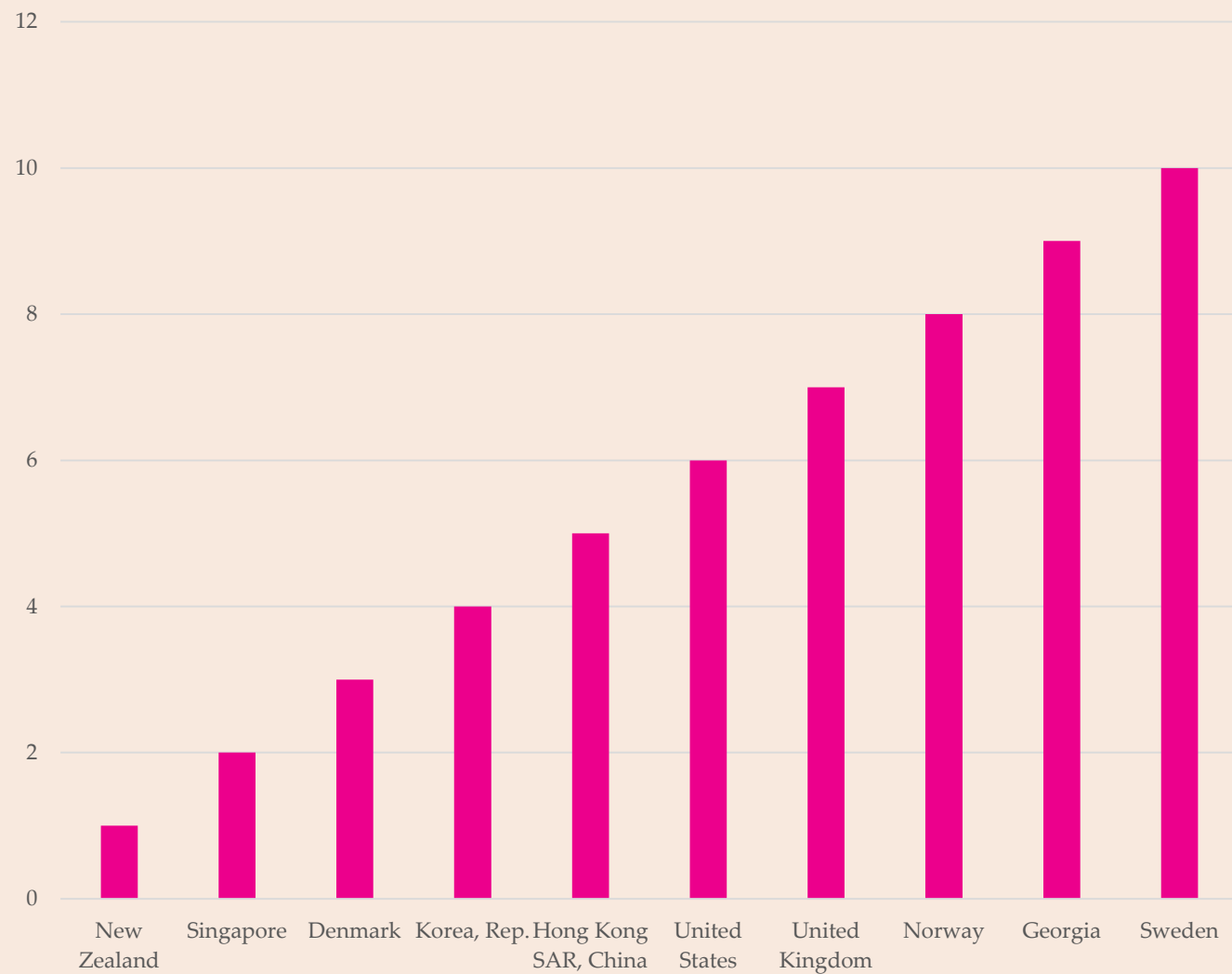


We are not good at attracting foreign investments
